
SSSTFUW includes like-minded individuals in partnership with enabled individual and corporates for the betterment of the society.

Apart from the upcoming free-of-cost cancer hospital, housing for the needy families, hunger alleviation activities etc., the trust has forayed into the activity of providing free drinking water through RO water plants for the villages.

With summer flaring to high temperatures, the trust is now providing buttermilk to over 10,000 people on an average daily! This has also brought in participation from students and elders.

The trust also started with medical camps in rural areas serving hundreds through many specializations. We had 2 camps in April.

It goes without saying that all this is not possible without your support and encouragement! We thank you for your participation and support, and we pray that you get more opportunities to serve the needy!

We are excited to open this temple of healing for the needy in just a few months! We thank you all for your great support and participation!






SRI SATHYA SAI DIVYA PRAASADAM (DIVINE HOUSING PROJECT)

In November 2021, a project to support the homeless by providing constructed homes with all amenities was launched. About 12 needy families will be recipients of this project 'Sri Sathya Sai Divya Praasadam' where the families will now have a permanent shelter in the form of newly built houses. Each house will cover an area of around 65 - 75 sq. yards. These beneficiary families from a needy background, through the Divine Housing Project, will be able to lead respectable lives that will allow them to seek respectable livelihoods.

The construction of various houses are in different stages and are on track to ensure that the needy families will receive the Divine gift at the earliest.





Month Updates

SRI SATHYA SAI DIVYA JALAM

The trust launched the 'Sri Sathya Sai Divya Jalam' project that will help needy and rural populace to get access to clean drinking water right at their villages. As a part of this launch, a Bhoomi Pooja was conducted for setting up an RO Plant in the village of Sri Sai Pale (Chinnakandepalli), near Thatupudi reservoir in Vizianagaram.

The villagers have no access to drinking water, despite having a reservoir nearby. In order to bring respite to their struggle and provide them with their most basic need of drinking water, the trust is building this RO plant, under the Sri Sathya Sai Divya Jalam project, to enable them to have access to drinking water daily in their own village. The pure water will be provided to all families in the village, while the residual water will be put to other domestic use. The plant will start operations in a month's time.



DIVINE MEDICAL CAMPS

On Sunday, the 24th April, Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare conducted a mega medical camp at Sri Sai Pale (Chinnakandepalli) near Thatipudi reservoir in Vizianagaram Dist., Close to the upcoming free-of-cost cancer treatment hospital 'Sri Sathya Sai Divyaamritam', this village is cut off from quick and affordable access to basic medical facilities. Various health check up facilities were provided for the villagers' benefit. Close to 200 patients were provided free screening, consultation as well as medicines. 60 of them discussed their concerns with the general practitioner, 59 with the orthopaedic, 43 with the ophthalmologist, 22 with the gynaecologist and 14 with the dentist. All the patients were served Divya Prasadam after they finished the consultation. Similarly, a second mega medical camp was arranged at Pedagantyada at Visakhapatnam on 30th April 2022.

The Trust strongly believes that prevention is better than cure. Thus such rural medical camps are of prime importance to the rural populace who have otherwise learnt to live with their health problems. The patients' eyes glistened with gratitude as they experienced unique Love in quality health care made available to them at their doorsteps.



SAI BUTTERMILK SEVA

On the holy day of Vishu, April 15th, the trust started the buttermilk seva to quench the thirst of people during the hot summer. The seva will continue through the peak summer until June 15th. The elixir in the form of buttermilk will help quench the thirst, regulate blood pressure during the hot summer and more importantly keep the gut in good shape and facilitate detoxification of the body.

About 10,000 people are benefitting everyday across two locations in Kothavalasa main junction in Vizianagaram and Pedagantyada four line junction in Visakhapatnam.



DIVYA PRASADA SEVA (in 2 locations)

Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare, over more than the last 230 days, has been reaching out to needy people in the nights, serving them dinner daily. The needy are unable to access food in the night, thus sleeping in an empty stomach. Sri Sathya Sai Divya Prasada Seva thus addresses this and helps eliminate night hunger for many needy people.



Now, the team has taken this forward to reach out to more nooks and corners, with the help of a food carrying vehicle, which can now take food to many more needy people in various corners covering more distance, that were earlier not accessible. Currently more than 100 needy people are provided with Divya Prasadam at night.



SWAYAM PAKA SEVA

It is our constant endeavour to serve the needy and to benefit more and more of needy families in various ways. Called Sai Swayampakam Seva, this helps the needy families, who are unable to make their ends meet, to cook food as per their convenience and quantity. This makes the needy independent of reaching out daily for food, but plan a livelihood now that they are assured of food grains. There are many instances where the needy families even use this over multiple months.

Some of the 21 beneficiary families this month are a single widow residing in a temporary shed, a migrant family with 2 blind children, a single mother with an infant, a few single widow women partially blind with ill health and in poor living conditions, and various others like a family with a mentally challenged person, multiple families with divyanga children or divyanga family members etc.



SRI RAMANAVAMI CELEBRATIONS

A great festive atmosphere filled the air of Vizianagaram's Thatipudi area. Blessed with a reservoir, and soon to be gifted with Bhagawan Baba's free-of-cost cancer hospital, Sri Sai Palle (Chinnakandepalli) that is about 40kms from Visakhapatnam welcomed Lord Rama's Birth by transforming itself into Sai Palle!



The Divine marriage of Lord Rama and His Divine Consort Goddess Seetha was conducted in a grand manner to everyone's content. It is our great fortune that this year "Shubakrut Samvatsara" is the very year back in Treta Yuga when Mother Seetha and Lord Rama's Divine Marriage took place.



Beautiful new clothes for the needy in the village and a grand lunch (Divya Prasadam) for all added more colour to the festivity. The villagers took a leading part in the celebrations and lent their hands to support the team of volunteers. The evening saw a palanquin procession that brought Bliss to everyone.



It was a very memorable day for the team, as service transformed into Divine Love this day, on holy Birthday of Lord Rama.



DIVYA PRASADAM FOR 13,000 PEOPLE at PENTAMMA THALLI FESTIVAL

Pentamma Thalli temple is an ancient temple in the area of Gajuwaka in Visakhapatnam that is famous for its fair (village festival) held around Chaitra Pournami time. Thousands of devotees from about 35 nearby villages through the village to pay their offerings to Pentamma Thalli.


Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare set up a stall to provide Divya Prasadam and buttermilk to ensure that devotees from far-off do not remain hungry and thirsty. About 13,000 people benefitted by having over 200 kgs of sweet and tamarind rice (pulihora). Close to 1400 liters of buttermilk was distributed to quench the thirst of all on this hot summer day.



Relief Activity for Fire Accident Victims

Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare jumped into action after an unfortunate fire accident struck a house in Rangapuram village in L. Kota mandal in Vizianagaram.

Immediate relief was provided in terms of a month's grocery to ensure that the family doesn't go hungry. We pray for the family's well being.


