

SRI SATHYA SAI DIVYA PRAASADAM (DIVINE HOUSING PROJECT)

A key and significant welfare project to support the homeless, in the form of providing neatly constructed homes, was launched in November 2021.



About 12 needy families will be recipients of this project 'Sri Sathya Sai Divya Praasadam' where the families will now have a permanent shelter in the form of newly built houses. Each house will cover an area of around 65 - 75 sq. yards.

These beneficiary families from a needy background, through the Divine Housing Project will be able to lead respectable lives that will allow them to seek respectable livelihoods.

MAHASHIVARATRI PRASADAM for 10000 devotees

The Divine Festival of Maha Shivaratri was celebrated by Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare by serving devotees in large scale.

The temple of Sri Sanyaseshwara in Vizianagaram is of great historical significance where Lord Shiva's Lingam self manifested long ago with the prayers of devotees. Tens of thousands of devotees visit here on the holy festival of Mahashivaratri.

The team served Divya Prasadam for over 10,000 people across 24 hours during the holy occasion of Mahashivratri. Rice items like Pulihora, Tomato rice, upma etc. along with biscuits, buttermilk, juices and fruit salads and water were served to over 10,000 devotees who visited the temple.

Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare, over the last 175 days have been reaching out to needy people in the nights, serving them dinner daily. The needy are unable to access food in the night, thus sleeping in an empty stomach. Sri Sathya Sai Divya Prasada Seva thus addresses this and helps eliminate night hunger for many needy people.

Now, the team has taken this forward to reach out to more nooks and corners, with the help of a food carrying vehicle, which can now take food to many more needy people in various corners covering more distance, that were earlier not accessible. Recently, with the addition of one more location of Gajuwaka area in Visakhapatnam, 20 more madhukaris were identified taking the total past 100!

The team believes that every needy brother and sister deserves to get a facelift and thus lead a respectful life. 4 Madhukaris benefited with the Sri Sathya Sai Sanatha Seva at Gnanapuram port road near Visakhapatnam Railway station. Also 108 Madhukaris in the surrounding areas were provided with Divya Prasadam.


