Sri Sathya Sai Trust for Universal Welfare (SSSTFUW) is a Public charitable trust headquartered in Hyderabad, Telangana, India.



Year End Review



OPD BLOCK INAUGURATION & BHOOMI POOJA of STAFF QUARTERS

SRI SATHYA SAI DIVYAAMRITAM

November 23rd 2022 was a red-letter day in the field of healthcare as it involved the grand inauguration of the OPD Block of Sri Sathya Sai Divyaamritam, a free-of-cost comprehensive cancer treatment facility at Sri Sai Pale near Thatipudi reservoir close to Visakhapatnam.



In the previous evening (22nd Nov), the honourable Minister of Education of Andhra Pradesh, Sri Botcha Satyanarayana, in the presence of the local area's MLC, MLA, the District Collector, and the RDO local Panchayat administrators performed the Bhoomi Pooja of Staff Quarters.

DIVYA PRASADA SEVA

NIGHT HUNGER ALLEVIATION

Called as competition-less seva, this programme aims to provide relief to the needy, who are unable to get access to food in the night. While the day time sees selfless samaritans provide support to the needy, it is the dinner meal gap that this seva aims to bridge. Daily, over 120 Madhukaris (beneficiaries) are provided with a dinner meal that changes everyday with a unique 7-day menu. The seva has seen a large amount of transformation in the Madhukaris, many of who try to pay it forward by serving in their capacity. Some are now able to seek a livelihood now that they are assured of a meal at night. Overall, more than 55,000 meals have been served through this seva.



SAI SWAYAM PAKAM

DRY RATIONS FOR NEEDY

Sai Swayampaka Seva is an initiative to support needy families and motivate them to seek improved livelihood. Under this initiative, the trust supports them with monthly groceries to enable them to cook good quality food as per their convenience and desired quantity. The beneficiaries include families whose breadwinners are unable to make ends meet, or where the children are physically challenged, or those of some migrated labourers with no ration cards or access to government aid, and of those whose family elders have medical problems, or of needy single parents etc.

Every month, around 25 needy families across various areas near Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam and Hyderabad benefit from the seva. This makes the needy families overcome the need to reach out daily for food, and instead helps them plan a livelihood now that they are assured of food grains for a month.



NOTEBOOK DRIVE

Benefitting 11000 children

Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare, as a part of an initiative powered by its education wing, has outreached to 11,000+ rural government school children in various districts in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana through the Notebook Drive, where each student was gifted with 4 high quality crown size notebooks to support their educational cause. As the parents of most of these students are dependent on daily wages, they are often unable to support educational investments like books for their children. The trust distributed close to 45,000 notebooks to support the education of the young budding minds across Pedagantyada mandal in Visakhapatnam, S. Kota mandal in Vizianagaram in Andhra Pradesh, and in various areas in Telangana like Bibinagar in Yadadri district, Bachannapet in Jangaon district, in Siddipet district, and Kotapalli mandal in Mancherial district.



BLANKETS DRIVE

2000 Blankets for Needy

To help the needy beat the chill winter, Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare has started a drive to provide blankets amongst the needy and underprivileged. Over 2000 blankets will be distributed as a part of this drive.

The first phase of the blanket drive that benefitted 500 families took place in the tribal area in S. Kota mandal in Vizianagaram. The honorable MLC of the area took a leading part in the distribution programme. The second phase occurred in the needy tribal village of Kothamalisingaram in Araku Valley.

The warmth of love reciprocated by the beneficiaries far superceeded the warmth provided by us through the blanket drive!



DESKTOPS DRIVE

Bridging Rural Digital Gap

In order to commemorate 75 years of Independence and to sow seeds for India's Glorious Future, Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare celebrated the entire red-letter day of the 76th Independence Day at various rural and remote schools near Visakhapatnam and Vizianagaram empowering young minds in various ways.

Desktop Computer sets were provided to 5 of our adopted schools near Visakhapatnam and Vizianagaram. The children were excited that they will soon get to work on a computer system. We believe this will be a step towards bridging the digital gap characteristic in rural areas. This will also empower children as well teachers in their academic journey.



FREE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTE

Educating a child educated the village



Marking the 50th Eswaramma Day on 6th May 2022, with the blessings of Bhagawan Baba, Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare performed the Bhoomi Pooja for "SRI SATHYA SAI DIVYA BHARATI", a residential School free of cost for Girls, that provides education free of cost upto 12th standard.

Mother Eswaramma, decades back in Puttaparthi, requested Baba to start a girls' institute, which went on to become the first Sathya Sai institute ever. It is indeed a great tribute to Mother Eswaramma, on her 50th Anniversary, that another girls' school is getting established. This temple of learning would come up at Sri Sai Palle (Chinakhandepalli) in Vizianagaram district near Thatipudi reservoir.

SAI SCHOLARSHIPS

Supporting needy students

In a move to further support the cause of education for students from economically challenged background, Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare has a streamlined 'Sai Scholarships' programme for needy students. Apart from supporting them in their educational pursuit, students are also provided with laptops or tablets to aid their academics. Over a hundred students have been supported through this scheme.



RO DRINKING WATER PLANTS

SRI SATHYA SAI DIVYA JALAM

Bhagawan Baba, out of His Love for the rural populace that do not have a regular access to drinking water, has guided that RO Plants be setup in needy villages under the umbrella of Sri Sathya Sai Divya Jalam.



With this, the villagers will be able to get daily access to free-of-cost drinking water right at their village instead of having to travel a distance to access water. Currently, RO Plants are functional in Ganivada village and Sri Sai Pale near Thatipudi reservoir area.



MEGA MEDICAL CAMPS

SAI AAROGYA

In order to take healthcare to the doorstep of the rural populace, the trust is arranging a mega medical camp that would be free of cost for all. The trust partnered with key medical bodies like AIIMS Bibinagar, District Medical Health Office of Yadadri Bhuvanagiri district and was ably supported by honourable District Collectors.

Overall, over 1000 from rural areas took benefit of various specialties such as General, Gynaecology, Dental, and Ophthalmology. Follow-ups were conducted and more than 30, who were prescribed spectacles, were provided with spectacles free of cost.



BLOOD DONATION DRIVES

Multiple Blood donation drives were conducted on various occasions, which encouraged youth and others to participate in large numbers near Visakhapatnam and Vizianagaram.

These drives are expected to provide timely help to hundreds of patients in need of blood.



SAI SANATHA SEVA

Bhagawan Baba often says all of us are His children and there are no orphans (anathas) in this world, for the Lord is the Eternal Divine Parent of all. Inspired by these words, Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare has initiated a noble service activity of sharing love with the homeless. Named *Sri Sathya Sai Sanatha Seva*, the team reaches out to the homeless and helps spruce them up and provides them with new clothes. The beneficiaries (lovingly called as Madhukaris) are further provided with Divya Prasadam in the form of meals.

The team believes that every needy brother and sister deserves to get a facelift and thus lead a respectful life.



BUTTERMILK SEVA

QUENCHING PARCHED THROATS

Sai Buttermilk Seva provided succour to the thirsty during the peak arid summer in Visakhapatnam and Vizianagaram areas. The seva took place for almost 50 days, overall serving lakhs of cups of buttermilk. The buttermilk seva brought smiles both to the volunteers as well as to the beneficiaries.

While more than 8000 people on an average have been able to keep themselves cool in the scorching heat by benefiting from this buttermilk seva daily from these centers, there are beautiful instances that cool our hearts as well. Called as Rays on Inspirations, there are selfless souls who, having been benefitted from this seva, participate in the seva in various ways voluntarily. While some join the team to serve more people, some contribute by preparing or procuring more buttermilk so that more and more people may get benefitted. These rays of inspirations are from various walks of life such as school children, homemakers, senior citizens etc.



SUMMER CAMP

360-degree development of young minds

The 4 days between 12th and 15th of May were filled with smiles, cheer and active learning for about 190 children between 6th and 12th classes. The Divine Summer Camp organized by Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare had a long list of activities that sets a foundation for children's all round development including yoga, sports, educatoional sessions etc.

Overall, there were 11 sessions involving 10 Gurus across esteemed spiritual institutes like Yoga Consciousness Trust, Om Santhi Organization, Art of Living, Chinmaya Mission and the Chinna Jeeyar Organization. 190 children benefitted and about 100 parents were present. Bags and gifts were distributed the children at the end. The team conducted due diligence while reaching out to the beneficiaries. The beneficiaries include single mothers with dependent children, needy families unable to make ends meet, needy families where the male members were unable to earn etc. We believe this drive would help these families towards a better future.



WHEELCHAIRS FOR DIVYANGS

As a part of the holy celebrations of Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba 's 97th Birthday, Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare has been reaching out to 50 Divyangs with equipment (wheelchair) that would help them become more self reliant.



SRI LAKSHMI NARASIMHA SWAMI TEMPLE INAUGURATION

The proceedings at the Sri Lakshmi Narasimha Swami Vari Vighraha Prathishta (installation of idol) ceremony were electrifying as the Priests went on for three days continuously consecrating the idol in various ways to invoke the blessings of the Lord, to install Himself at this new Abode of His by energising the idol. The idol was offered Abhishekam in several ways after smearing sandalwood paste all over; then burning Sambrani powder to purify the atmosphere; Chanting of Vedic hymns before it was shifted into the Garbhaalaya (Sanctum Santorum) reaching out to 13'6" at its top from the ground level.

The idol of His devotee, young lad, Prahlada was also placed close to his saviour. In His revelations made during the Divine Discourse, as to why an idol of Prahlada had also to be placed, Swami clarified that God and devotee go together for, there cannot be the God without a Devotee and there cannot be a devotee without the God. Swami went on to say that "if you're with the God everything comes to you. Whatever Narasimha receives as offering Prahlada would also get".



GLOBAL AKHANDA BHAJANS




SAI LITERATURE


