

Sri Sathya Sai Trust for Universal Welfare (SSSTFUW) is a Public charitable trust headquartered in Hyderabad, Telangana, India.




NOTEBOOK DRIVE

FOR 11,000 RURAL SCHOOL CHILDREN



Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare, as a part of an initiative powered by its education wing, has set about to touch the lives of 11,000+ rural government school children in various districts in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana through the Notebook Drive, where each student will be gifted with 4 high quality crown size notebooks to support their educational cause. As the parents of most of these students are dependent on daily wages, they are often unable to support educational investments like books for their children.





As a part of this , Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare has, as a Diwali gift, distributed close to 45,000 notebooks to support the education of the young budding minds across Pedagantyada mandal in Visakhapatnam, S. Kota mandal in Vizianagaram in Andhra Pradesh, and in various areas in Telangana like Bibinagar in Yadadri district, Bachannapet in Jangaon district, in Siddipet district, and Kotapalli mandal in Mancherial district.

MEGA MEDICAL CAMP

Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare has been providing succour to needy in various fields including free healthcare services. In addition to the upcoming free of cost comprehensive cancer treatment hospital 'Sri Sathya Sai Divyaamritam near Thatipudi close to Visakhapatnam,

the trust is also taking free primary health care to rural areas through medical camps.

In continuation to the multiple medical camps conducted over the last few months in various districts, Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare today conducted a mega free medical camp at Ganivada village in L.Kota mandal in Vizianagaram district.

191 people underwent medical screenings, of whom 110 consulted

the general physician. While 25 women used the services of the gynecologist, 42 patients used the dentist's availability. Advanced consultations like oncology and cardiology were also made available. About 118 people were screened for BP and Diabetes. Medicines prescribed were provided free of cost to the beneficiaries.

Sri Lakshmi Narasimha Swami Temple

Vigraha Pratistapana

The recently concluded holy Navarathri Celebrations, at the holy site of SRI SATHYA SAI DIVYAAMRITAM at Sri Sai Palle near Thatipudi reservoir close to Visakhapatnam, witnessed the installation of Sri Lakshmi Narasimha Swami vaari idol along with that of Bhakta Prahlada in the temple that Swami chose to construct in the Divine precincts. This holy event, interspersed during Navarathri, was performed in a grand manner across 4 days.

Day 1: 2nd Oct 2022

The proceedings of the installation of idol of the Lord Narasimha Swami along with that of His consort Mother Lakshmi and His Devotee Prahlada commenced in the evening that coincided with the 7th day of the Navarathri, with the 4th day of the Veda Purusha Saptaha Jnana Yagnam and with the 2nd day of the 2-day Grama Seva launched at the Darbha Bhoomi (as one of the Ritwiks described the precincts).



Punyaha Vachanam was performed where the holy location was consecrated with 21 sacred waters brought from various rivers and pilgrimage centres and Vedic chanting.

Day 2: 3rd Oct 2022

In the morning Suprabhatam, Agni pratishta, Dhanwantari havanam, laghu Poornaahuti, naivedyam, Mangala haarati distribution of prasadam were performed, amidst other rituals performed by the SriVaishnavite priests with immaculate precision.

In the latter part of the day, Jalaadhivasam, Nithya Homam, Maha Ganapathi Prathishta; Adivaasa Havanam, laghu Poornaahuti Veda Vinnapamu, Teertha Goshti, distribution of Prasadam were performed. It was a feast to the eyes watching the proceedings of making the idol rest in the sacred waters. The day also witnessed amidst Veda chantings the various rituals performed by the Ritwik Vaishnavite priests. The chief priest described Lord Narasimha as the Ocean of Compassion and that it is the immense fortune of the people in the region to have received the attention of the Lord in the form of Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba vaaru as they're sure to have Swamis' protection in myriad forms.



Later consecration of the idol of Sri Lakshmi Narasimha Swami continued with the abhishekam performed with water, Panchaamritams . The idol was then placed as per Vedic prescription under the cover of paddy.

Day 3: 4th Oct 2022

In the Sri Lakshmi Narasimha temple yagashala the Homa was performed with the idols consecrated continuously by water and milk while the idol remained in the specially designed and constructed tank. The idol was then carefully brought out to be

consecrated further with Sandalwood paste smeared all over the idol. It was a treat to the eyes and the Divine aroma filled the atmosphere all over. Nrisimha Mantra, Purusha Sooktam, Narasimha Kavachyyham and many other Vedic chantings filled the area with Divine vibrations. Heavy rain showers by God Varuna did not hinder any proceedings within the Yaga shaala. Bhajans were sung and Vedic chanting continued with same fervour. At about 8:48 pm the Stapati submitted to Swami that the Vighraha Prathishta (installation of idol) can be done the next morning at 10:03 AM and the same was approved by Swami.



Day 4: 5th Oct 2022

After offering the Poornahuti in the Homa Kunda at the Veda Purusha Saptaha Jnana Yajnam Yagashaala, Swami crossed over to the Sri Lakshmi Narasimha Swami vari Yagashaala. The Yaagashaala reverberated with Vedic chanting and with Sri Narasimha Mantra, Sri Narasimha Kavacha Stotram, Sri Narasimha Chaturdasi Maha Mantra, Purusha Sooktam, Sri Vishnu Sahasra Naamam etc..


The proceedings at the Sri Lakshmi Narasimha Swami Vari Vighraha Prathishta (installation of idol) ceremony were electrifying as the Priests went on for three days continuously consecrating the idol in various ways to invoke the blessings of the Lord, to install Himself at this new Abode of His by energising the idol. The idol was offered Abhishekam in several ways after smearing sandalwood paste all over; then burning Sambrani powder to purify the atmosphere; Chanting of Vedic hymns before it was shifted into the Garbhaalaya (Sanctum Santorum) reaching out to 13'6" at its top from the Ground level. A day before the installation proceedings commenced the Priest made a statement out of blue saying that the presence of Lord Vishnu gets confirmation when the proceedings commence next day evening in the Sandhya Samayam (the time when the transition from day to dusk happens) and a Vulture, the divine carrier of Lord Vishnu (Garuda), appears in the sky when Swami arrives into the Divine precincts. When the Lord arrived into His Abode the Ritwik rushed to Swami to confirm having seen a Vulture flying above the Abode as the day started turning into dusk and simultaneously the incarnation of the Yuga arrived. The pristine glow of surrender in the face of the Priest got reflected in the face of none less than the incarnation of the Age.

As a part of the ongoing Veda Purusha Saptaha Jnana Yagyam (Navarathri Celebrations 2022), Grama Seva was held that benefited over 500 families in 11 villages. Each one of the families were provided with new dresses such as sarees and dhotis. They were also provided with Divya Prasadam in the form of 2 packets of Pulihora (tamarind rice) and 2 laddus. The various villages covered in the Grama Seva are a part of the neighbouring areas to the upcoming free-of-cost comprehensive cancer treatment hospital Sri Sathya Sai Divyaamritam near Thatipudi reservoir. Thus, the love of Bhagawan Baba overflowing in Sri Sai Pale poured into neighbouring villages in the form of Grama Seva.

In order to support needy families and motivate them to seek improved livelihood, Sri Sathya Sai Trust For Universal Welfare, through the 'Sai Swayampaka Seva', ensures that the needy families are assured of food grains.

Under this initiative, the trust supports them with monthly groceries to enable them to cook good quality food as per their convenience and desired quantity. This makes the needy families overcome the need to reach out daily for food, and instead helps them plan a livelihood now that they are assured of food grains for a month.



This month, 25 needy families across various areas in Hyderabad and Visakhapatnam benefitted from the seva. The beneficiaries include families whose breadwinners are not able to eke out a living due to impairment, the children are physically challenged, of some migrated labourers with no ration cards or

no access to government aid, and of those whose family elders have medical problems, of needy single parents etc

Navarathri Celebrations & Veda Purusha Saptaha Jnana Yagnam

IN DIVINE PRESENCE

Day 1: Navarathri Celebrations 2022

The 10-day long Celebrations, designed for invoking the blessings of Divine mothers Maha Kali, Maha Lakshmi and Maha Saraswati and to earn the Grace of our Swami Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba Who is none other than the Veda Purusha took off in a grand manner as scheduled on Monday, 26th September. The morning session started with an invocation to Lord Ganesha through a pooja followed by a Go Pooja offered in gratitude to mother cow.




Kalasha Stapana was performed followed by many important rituals, like Punyahavachanam for sanctifying the precincts; Raksha Bandhana dharana; Ritwik Varana followed by Deeksha Vastra Dharana for preparing the Ritwiks to do their part during the Dasara Samarambhaalu. Thereafter, Yagashala pravesham took place and mandapaaradhana was performed followed by chanting Rudram and Lalita Sahasra Naama. The evening session had the renowned Smt. Madhavi Krishna garu offering various divine tunes soulfully at the Lotus Feet of Baba.

Day 2: Navarathri Celebrations 2022

The second day, Tuesday, 27th September, witnessed a brisk early morning start. Sacrifices were offered in to the Yagna Homam during the first session to invoke the blessings of Divine Mother. This apart, Mandapaaradhana and Kalasharadhana were performed. The morning session was also blessed with Bhagawan Baba's Discourse. In His loving message, He reminded those present of the ancient Indian culture when Aaharam (food), Aarogyam (healthcare) and Aksharam (education) were served free for one and all irrespective of any demographic differences and guided that such a culture should be revived. Swami conveyed that the construction plans of OPD block for the upcoming free of cost comprehensive cancer treatment hospital Sri Sathya Sai Divyaamritam services are very much on schedule for inauguration in November. He concluded His Discourse calling upon everyone to act selflessly for everyone to become more selfless day by day.

The evening session started with Vedic chants. A musical programme followed, performed by renowned artist Sri Vijayakrishna garu and his team, who had performed for the Lord during Andhra Kodai trip. The battery of devotional offerings filled the evening with divine Bliss. The evening session was brought to a close with Arathi to Bhagawan followed by Divya Prasadam.





Day 3: Navarathri Celebrations 2022

The third day, 28th September, was celebrated with gaiety in dedication to Maa Chandraghanta, the married form of Goddess Parvati, an icon of fearlessness and courage. The morning session was initiated with homa, vedic chants and Go Pooja. Further, Mandapaaradhana and Kalasharadhana as scheduled for all the days were performed. The evening session reverberated with Vedic invocation and flowed into a musical vibe with the renowned artist Sri Venkateswara Rao and his team performing for the Lord with various melodious devotional songs. The evening session concluded after Aarathi was offered to Bhagawan followed by serving the Divya Prasadam. The festivities seemed to have ended for the day, but in reality they have opened gates into the new realms of ecstasy for the devotees as they awaited the commencement of the Veda Purusha Saptaaha Jnana Yagna scheduled from the next morning!



Day 4: Navarathri Celebrations 2022

COMMENCEMENT: VEDA PURUSHA SAPTAHA JNANA YAGYAM

The much awaited divine event of Veda Purusha Saptaha Jnana Yagyam, in the Divine Presence of Veda Purusha-Bhagawan Baba, commenced on this Thursday, the 29th September, coinciding with the 4th Day of the ongoing Navarathri festival.

The morning session began with an invocation to Ganapathi with a Pooja that was followed by Go (Mother Cow) Pooja. Post the Mandapaaradhana that followed next, Maha Sankalpam was performed.

The day vibrated with great energy driven by Rudra Havanam, Veda Parayanam, Surya Namaskaram, Chandi parayanam and Devi Bhagawatham. Bhajans followed thereafter, leading to a Satsang. The Divine Dictum of “not to entertain evil thoughts even for a moment and drive away even the ones that might sneak into the mind, per chance, that very moment” was inspiring for everyone to implement. The session was brought to a close with Mangala Arathi and Divya Prasadam.

The evening session started with Kalasharadhana followed by Lalitha Parayanam. The evening Satsang followed and led to the Bharatnatyam dance programme. The young dancers gave their best in presenting their skills to please the Lord. The session that gave yet another insight into the Indian culture and spirituality got concluded with Mangala Arathi and distribution of Divya Prasadam.





Day 5: Navarathri Celebrations 2022

The day brought the celebrations to the midway, to the culmination of celebrations awaiting to be experienced by all those who participated in the 5th day's festivities. The down pour of rain did not deter those who longed to be at The Lotus Feet while the offerings were made to the Divine Mother. The Yagna Praanganam continued to reverberate with Rudra chanting accompanied offerings to the Homam, Vedic Chantings, Veda Parayanam, Devi Bhagavata Parayanam. In His Divine discourse then, urging everyone, Swami manifested with many a benedictions as Jnana Pradaatha, to become aware of the Suddha Chaitanya Sakthi that is immanent in everyone that enables the digestion of food taken in and also operates the inhalation and exhalation uninterruptedly without any effort by any living being. The evening's cultural program wore an ethnic look with an electric, energetic Thappitigullu dance performance rendered non stop for 45 minutes by 15 members singing The Glory of Lord Rama in Telugu. This was followed by an enchanting Garidi dance recital in the company of a gigantic Nandi which did not shift its looks away from Swami throughout.





Day 6: Navarathri Celebrations 2022

At the Yaga Shala the day's proceedings continued in the form of Ganapathi Puja; Punyahavachanam; Mandapaaadhana; Chathushasti Yogini Mandapaaradhana, Kshetra Palakaaradhana; Vastu purusha Devataaraadhana; Navagrahaaradhana; kumkumaarchana; Rudrabhishekam and Chandi Homam. Poornaahuti was offered made by Swami. The Ritwik continued with the Veda Parayanam and expounded the essence of granthaas (scriptures) covered during the day. Speaking about Grama Seva, Swami said that He willed that by the year 2025 the number of people that would be served Divya Prasadam would increase to 50000, when the Ati Rudra Maha Yajnam would be performed. Swami thrilled the fortunate ones present by declaring that His Lakshyam (aim) is to make Sri Sai Palle another Puttaparthi like spiritual capital on the world map. In the evening session, Swami, in His Address, went on to emphasise that Love can achieve anything; that with Love one can live very happily even with limited resources; with love any number of obstacles can be overcome. He then went on to appreciate the services rendered by the teams despite the inclement weather during the Grama Seva. The cultural program was a treat to the ears and eyes as Smt. Kusuma sang through devotional songs suffused with lot of devotion. Swami relished the vocal offerings and lauded her performance and the involvement of all their family members in these offerings. Kumari Snigdha Sarvepalli studying in 6th standard then performed Bharathanatyam to the delight of Swami.



Day 7: Navarathri Celebrations 2022

The seventh day of the Sarannavaratrulu brought in more enthusiasm for the chosen ones. The morning pooja session included Surya Namaskaraalu along with Ganapathi Puja, Rudrabhishekam Rudra Homam, Veda Parayanam Go-Puja and other worships performed daily. Swami, after offering Poornaahuti as Veda Purusha, in His Divine Discourse enlightened the significance the day brought with it that the day happens to be a repeat of what happened 60 years back when Swami then performed Veda Purusha Saptaaha Jnana Yagnam for the first time in Puttaparti and it happened to be again a Bhanuvaram (Sunday) with Moola Nakshatram. The day also becomes significant in as much Ankuraarpanam (initiation of process for installation of idols) was initiated for the Sri Lakshmi Narasimha Swami idols installation, in the holy precincts of the project, by Rithvik Priests from the Vaishnavite tradition.



In the evening session, Goddess Mother Saraswati pooja was performed following which Swami performed Annapraasana, Naamakarana and Aksharabhyaasa for a number of children. The day's programs ended with a vocal recital by Preeti Mahathi sisters.



Day 8: Navarathri Celebrations 2022

The day 8 is significant for two reasons - performing Durga Pooja and Kanya Kumari puja. Ganapathi Pooja, Mandapaaraadhana, worship of Kshetra Palakaas, Vaastu Purusha, Navagrahaas, and Kumkum puja were performed. Rudrabhishekam and Rudra Homam followed all the worships in the morning session that started with vedic chanting. Poornaahuti was offered on Swami's arrival to the Yaagashaala. Swami was pleased with the Vedic chanting and narrations offered by the Ritwiks who did the Ramayana, Devi Bhagavata Parayana and Veda Parayana. After the Poornahuti was offered Swami, as part of kanya pooja went on to bless the Kanyas-the girls between the ages of 2 and 10, who were worshipped by washing their feet by Swami's devotees. Revered as forms of Mother Durga, these 9 children were then smeared vermilion tilak on their foreheads, tied thoranam (tying thread around wrist) and were then offered Naivedyam and Mangala Haarati to invoke the blessings of Goddess Durga believed to be present in them.



Swami then said that SRI SATHYASAI DIVYAAMRITAM which is to be inaugurated on Nov 23rd this year, would commence its operations as scheduled. Swami highlighted that the hospital, that would serve the needy totally free of cost is designed to be located at the centre of three adjacent districts of Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam and Srikakulam in the vicinity of River Gosthani.





The day also witnessed amidst Veda chantings the various rituals performed by the Ritwik Vaishnavite priests who came to carry out the Praana Prathishta of the Sri Lakshmi Narasimha idol. During the day Homam was performed and the Pournahuti was offered by Swami, the Veda Purusha. Swami then went on to add that the area is going to witness hunger alleviation, relief for patients suffering from cancer and kidney ailments requiring dialysis, and annihilation of illiteracy by providing free of cost education facilities as well. Later consecration of the idol of Sri Lakshmi Narasimha Swami continued with the abhishekam performed with water, Panchaamritams. The idol was then placed as per Vedic prescription under the cover of paddy while several other Vedic rituals awaited to be performed the next day. The day's celebrations concluded with a cultural programme wonderfully rendered by Smt Nori Gayatri and Lahori with the accompaniment of P Suresh on the mridangam, followed by distribution of Divya Prasadam.



Day 9: Navarathri Celebrations 2022

The penultimate day of the Sharannavaratri celebrations filled the Yaagashaala with Divine Energy that took everyone into the orbit of ecstasy. These experiences can neither be recorded in a visual nor described in an audio form but can only be perceived in the presence of the Divine. Indeed every moment has filled the hearts of all those present with Love, Love and Love alone. The morning session continued to resonate with Veda Parayanam along with other worships that were carried out all through from day one: Rudra Homam, Rudra Parayanam and Grantha Parayanam. Delighted by the recital of the Slokas from Daasarathi Satakam, Swami lauded the way Ramayana Grantha Parayanam was presented by one of the Ritwiks.



Swami said the village Sri Sai Palle will soon have Auto rickshaws moving in and out bringing people to Swami's Abode, a bus station, a railway station and an airport too. Swami's nectarine words went on to shower boons granting the performance of Athi Rudra Maha Yajnam in 2025. Swami, being pleased with Subramanyam Sarma and other Ritwiks for performing the Veda Purusha Saptaha Jnana Yagna, announced that they would perform next year too.





Swami also went on to reveal that the whole area within a radius of 10 kms from SRI SATHYA SAI DIVYAAMRITAM is cordoned off by a Naga bandham because of which no one can take away even an insignificant broom. Swami went on to say that this Naga bandham would start operating from the very day after the Vighraha Prathishta i.e the installation of idols. He assured that all villages within this area will have this protection. In the Sri Lakshmi Narasimha temple yaga shala, the Homa was performed with the idols consecrated continuously with one after the other - water, milk etc. while the idol remained in the specially designed and constructed tank. The idol was then carefully brought out to be consecrated further with Sandalwood paste smeared all over the idol. It was a treat to the eyes and the divine aroma filled the atmosphere all over. Nrisimha Mantra, Purusha Sooktam, Narasimha Kavacham and many other Vedic chantings filled the area with Divine vibrations. The evening session ended with a traditional dance programme brilliantly performed by young dance students.



Day 10: Navarathri Celebrations 2022

The Vijayadasami day that celebrates the victory of Good over evil arrived on the 5th of October, the 10th day of the Sharad Navratri celebrations. No one knew how the festival celebrations rolled over for 9 days. 
